The E-rate program is now stronger than ever!

Starting in 2021, \$8B in funding will be available over the next five-year budget cycle.





Understand the 2021 budget for your school.

Schools/districts: (Enrollment) x \$167 = total pre-discount budget \$ available.



Understand new funding calculation for libraries.

\$4.50 per square foot for all libraries (rural and urban), while the per-site funding "floor" will be increased to \$25,000.



Assess resources and manage application.

55% of schools and libraries say the application process is getting easier and faster.



Create a tech vision for your school or library.


Engage stakeholders, take a step back, and consider the big picture.



Prioritize IT infrastructure needs.

98% of applicants say their Wi-Fi network is critical to fulfilling their mission. 79% of applicants will need to upgrade their Wi-Fi within three years.







Use a competitive bidding process.

28 days of open bidding, as cost is the highest-weighted factor.



Get to know the E-rate Productivity Center (EPC).

55% agreed that it took less time to prepare and file applications this last year.



Identify matching and additional funding sources.

95% of applicants report that E-rate funds are not sufficient to meet their total needs.





Manage the process year-round.

Understand the deadlines and document work to stay ahead of the game.
