Ensuring safe and secure environments

83% of IT leaders say **employee security** is of the utmost importance when considering their organization's spaces

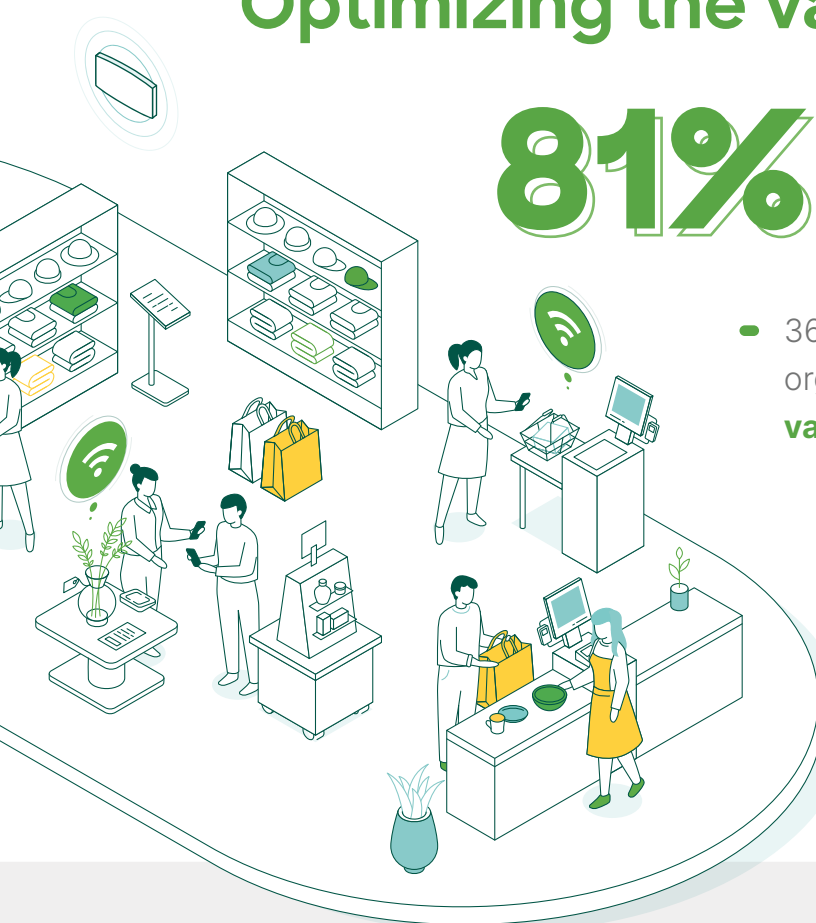
- **81%** consider the **physical safety of spaces** just as important as employee security
- Over **50%** agree that **building smarter spaces** could be highly beneficial to all aspects of their organization, **especially in regard to security**



Optimizing the value of your spaces

81% agree that their spaces must promote a **pleasant, productive engagement** with customers, students, and/or end users

- 36% say that a **smart approach** to their organization's spaces could **optimize the value of each space**
- 32% see the value in **building smarter spaces** to **cultivate the most effective environment** for customers and end users



Enhancing workflow and productivity

78% state that their employees believe their **spaces support collaboration**

- **52%** of IT leaders report **employee productivity and performance** as the **number one priority** for their organization
- **39%** report **workflow and employee turnover** as one of the **biggest challenges** for their organization currently
